"Revolutions. Upheavals, Changes, Utopias" is the thirteenth festival's theme and it's the same that Fabian

Albertini and Gabriela Maciel are engaged in this exhibition, expanding boundaries and questioning how

photograph can be revolutionary nowadays.

Fabian Albertini (1965, IT) presents new work from her latest series Light Perception. The process behind

Fabian's new photographs is complex - a series of images not using the camera but starting a new visual

possibility from a digital white module and using the effects of virtual light spectrum creating volume and

space. Exploring the field of abstraction, reformulating our understanding of the lights' effect, cousing a

state of transformation that is received and decoded by the viewer.

Gabriela Maciel (1977, BR) expanded the boundaries of photography by proposing a new physical

presence that has a life of its own beyond the original photograph, the work is much about its own material

than the image that it was born from. Gabriela began this series, Hyperpixel, in 2007 from an error

generated in the video edition where the time was overdriven and the color contrast was taken beyond that

the program could carry out. From this error was generated a language of hyperpixellization of the reality of

the photos and videos realized by the artist.
