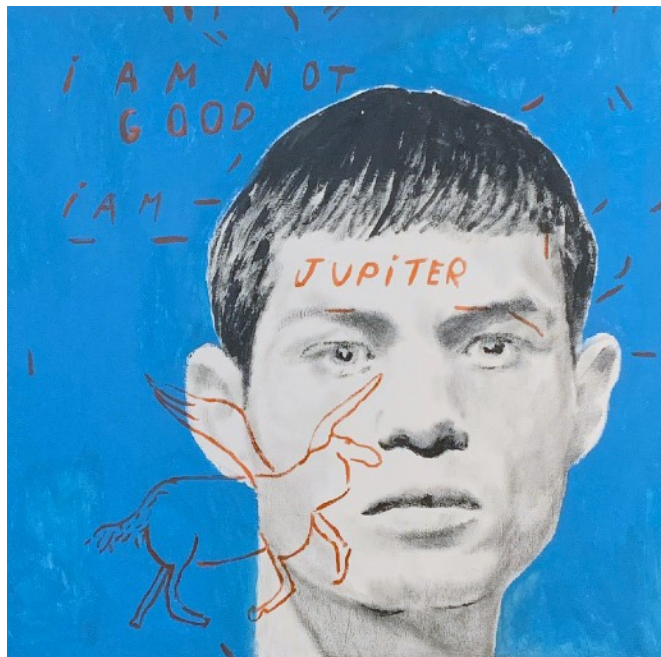


## THE COLOR OF THE SKY

**GABRIELA MACIEL (B.1975 RIO DE JANEIRO, BRAZIL)**

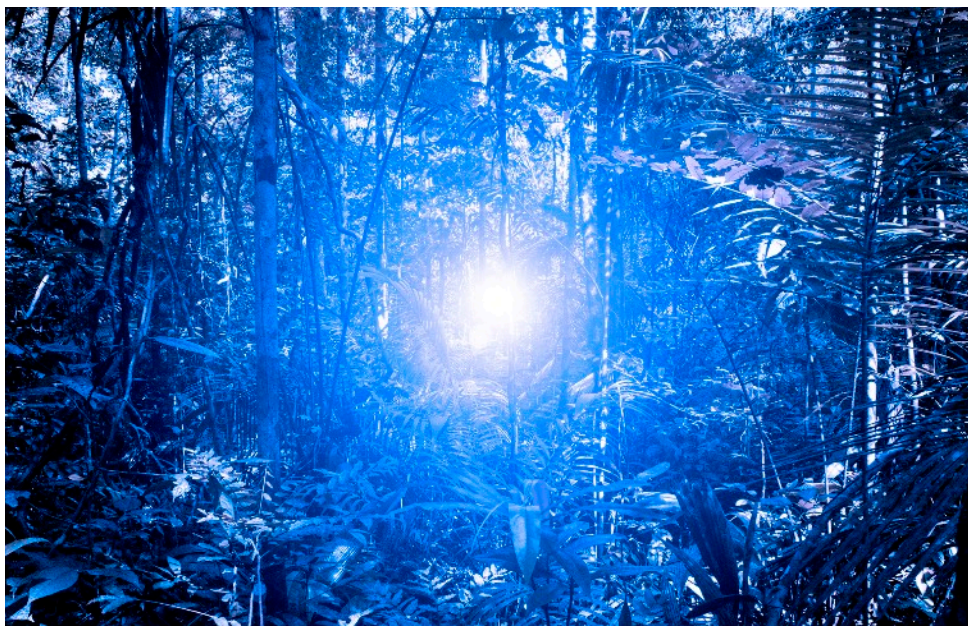
she researches subjects of art, nature, technology, immateriality and transdisciplinarity and works with concepts of the natural body within the contemporary society, from microcosm to macrocosm.
